Informational Items:

- Lateral Hiring Process
 - The Edwardsville Police Department (FPD) has three (3) police officers positions open due to retirements and resignations. There are thirteen (13) interviews scheduled for March 23rd and 24th with the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners for lateral hire candidates.
- Community Safety Meeting Report
 March 10th there was a Community Safety meeting attended by Major Mike Fillback.
 There was concern about car burglaries over the last two (2) to three (3) weeks. There was some discussion about subdivisions purchasing cameras and license plates readers.
- License Plate Reader Exploration The Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) has worked with local law enforcement throughout the state with license plates readers (LPR) on the interstates. There is a pattern of stolen vehicles with multiple passengers coming from St. Louis and stealing vehicle(s) on the Illinois side. Some local police agencies have purchased LPR systems and the DEA has made an agreement with local law enforcements that they would pay to store and give access to the data. A one-time expense to purchase a camera, install and software upgrades is estimated to be \$10,000.00. The cellular modem to send the

data to the Cloud is \$50.00 to \$60.00 per month per camera. The DEA would cover the cost to data storage if a Home Owner's Association (HOA) wanted to buy and install a LPR system and legally document giving it to the City of Edwardsville. A solution may be using the Energy Grant application to help HOAs to cover the cost of purchasing an LPR system.

Edwardsville Fire Department (EFD) is asking to refurbish and remount the patient box on the 2012 TerraStar ambulance to a new 2021 Ford F-550 chassis. This will have a warranty equivalent to a new ambulance.
