**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 18 ARTICLE XIII
OF THE EDWARDSVILLE CITY CODE,
INTERNATIONAL FUEL GAS CODE,
FOR THE CITY OF EDWARDSVILLE**

WHEREAS, the City of Edwardsville adopted the International Fuel Gas Code, 2021 Edition, as published by the International Code Council, regulates the design and installation of fuel gas distribution piping and systems, appliances, appliance venting systems, combustion air provisions, gaseous hydrogen systems and motor vehicle gaseous-fuel-dispensing stations as herein provided; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefor; and

WHEREAS, the City of Edwardsville finds that it is appropriate to review and update its building codes from time to time and believes it in the best interest of the community to adopt the current Fuel Gas Code.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDWARDSVILLE, MADISON COUNTY, ILLINOIS that:

Section 1. The following section of Chapter 18 Article XIII is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

Sec. 18-491. - Adoption of International Fuel Gas Code.

A certain document, being marked and designated as the International Fuel Gas Code, 2021 Edition, as published by the International Code Council, be and is hereby adopted as the Fuel Gas Code of the city regulates the design and installation of fuel gas distribution piping and systems, appliances, appliance venting systems, combustion air provisions, gaseous hydrogen systems and motor vehicle gaseous-fuel-dispensing stations as herein provided; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefor; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said fuel gas code on file in the office of the city are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this section, with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, prescribed in this section.

Section 2. The following section of Chapter 18 Article XIII is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

Section 101.1 Insert: City of Edwardsville

Section 115.4 Insert: Persons who shall violate a provision of this code or shall fail to comply with any of the requirements thereof or who shall erect, install, alter, repair or do work in violation of the approved construction documents or directive of the fuel gas code official, or of a permit or certificate used under provisions of this code, shall be guilty of an ordinance violation punishable by a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) or the then allowable maximum statutory amount or both such fine and imprisonment. Each day that a violation continues after due notice has been served shall be deemed a separate offense.

Section 3. That all other ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The city council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional.

Section 5. That nothing in this ordinance or in the Building Code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed as cited in Section 3 of this ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this ordinance.

Section 6. That the City Clerk is hereby ordered and directed to cause this ordinance to be filed and published in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois.

Section 7. That this ordinance and the rules, regulations, provisions, requirements, orders and matters established and adopted hereby shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after the date of its final passage and adoption on January 1, 2023.
